Consider being part of TOREV. TOREV is the Team of Radiological Emergency Response Volunteers. TOREV is a volunteer organization of radiation protection personnel. Its purpose is to augment the state's Radiation Protection Section in a nuclear incident such as a reactor accident, a RDD ("dirty bomb") incident, or other radioactive materials incidents.

Members of TOREV can be deployed in a number of roles, from actual field monitoring to logistical and other support to state personnel.
