

Lutz Moritz Named to HPS Honor Roll

On June 29, 2010, former Accelerator Section founding member, newsletter editor, and president Lutz Moritz (1943—2008) was named to the prestigious Health Physics Society Honor Roll. The purpose of the Honor Roll is to posthumously honor society members who significantly contributed to the profession of health physics during their careers, but were not otherwise honored by the Society during their lifetimes.
